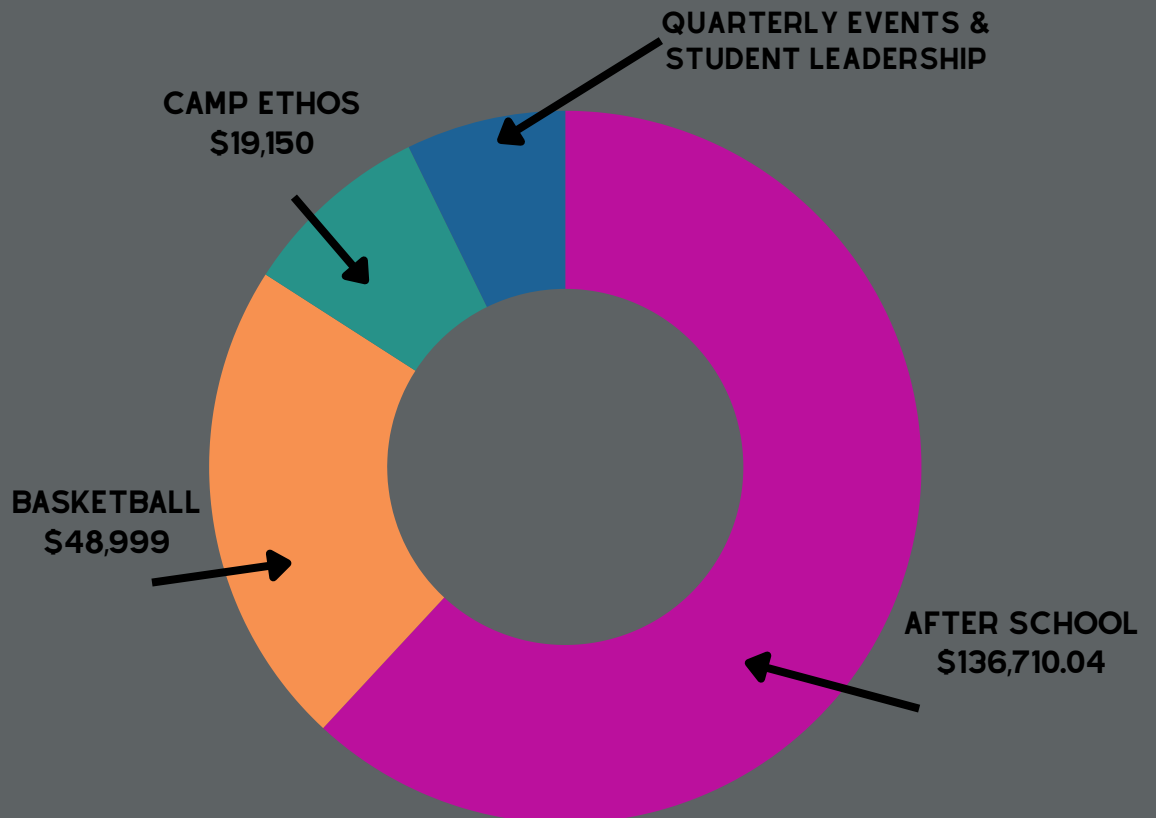

A 2,500sq. ft expansion on The Rock, the hub of all things Student Impact, is nearly finished. Construction expenses are fully funded allowing us to open for students in September, debt free. To date a total of \$377,852 has been raised by community and corporate donors local to Westfield.

## Monthly Donors

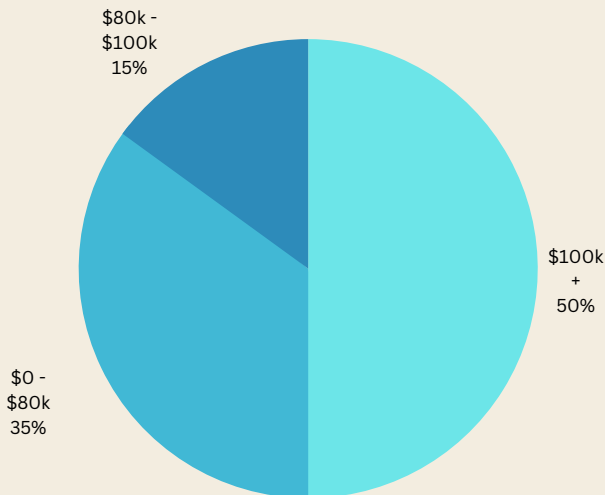

## Corporate Donors

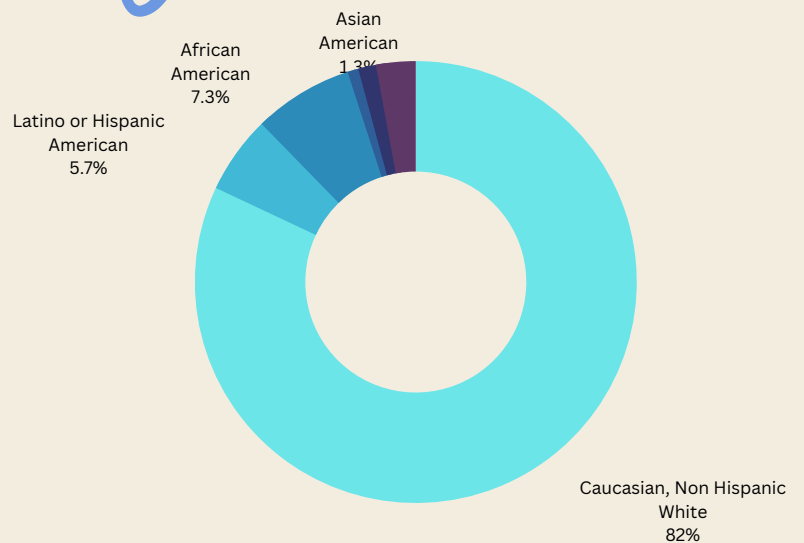
